

Sidewalk Dining Application Process

Sidewalk Dining Permit

Application (attached) for Sidewalk Dining Permit must be submitted with:

- \$100 check payable to “Metropolitan Government of Nashville & Davidson County”
- Brief written description & hand-sketched drawing of *Proposed Activities* to be conducted upon the indicated public right-of-way
- Copy of liability “Proof of Insurance” in amount not less than \$1,000,000

Beer Board Permit

A restaurant that wants to serve beer outdoors must complete an application and pay a \$250 fee (cash, check or money order). The following application and fee must be turned in to the Metropolitan Beer Permit office no later than 3:00 p.m. Monday-Friday. Application will need to be submitted in person.

In the letter specify that you are requesting permission to expand your premises. The following forms will need to be completed, along with a \$300 check made payable to TABC and mailed to the address listed below.
